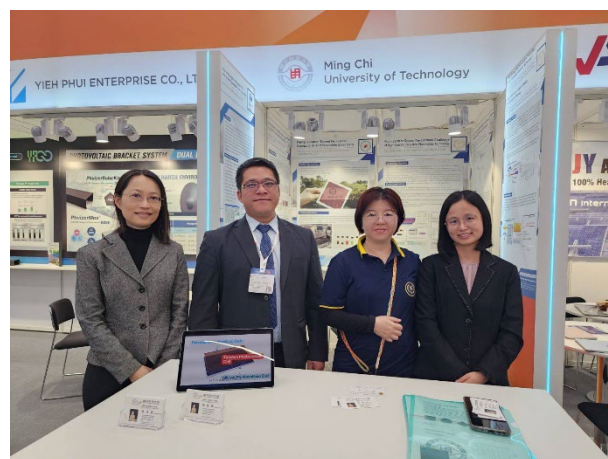
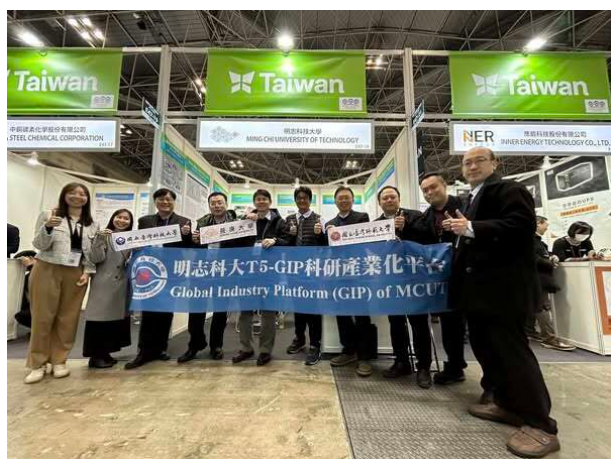

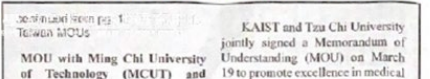

This collaboration aims to support the construction of lithium battery and electric commercial vehicle production lines, as well as to facilitate the development testing of all-solid-state battery manufacturing. KAIST was established by the Korean government in 1971 as the nation's first public, research-oriented science and engineering institution. KAIST is considered to be one of the most prestigious universities in the nation. KAIST and Seoul National University, Korea University, Yonsei University and Sungkyunkwan University are often among the top five in various Korean university rankings. The scope of this collaboration prioritizes technologies required for contemporary energy industries, including new battery energy technologies, electric vehicle technologies, and power management technologies. Together with Formosa Smart Energy Tech Corp. and Ming Chi University of Technology (MCUT), KAIST has signed a tripartite agreement endorsing enthusiasm for hastening the production lines of lithium batteries and electric commercial vehicles, and improving the development of all-solid-state battery manufacturing trials. The scope of this cooperation prioritizes technologies required by the contemporary energy industry, including but not limited to new battery energy technology, electric vehicle technology, and power management technology. The three parties will combine their strength to acknowledge the absolute renewal and accelerated growth of Taiwan's green and smart energy industry. Moreover, the memorandum also constitutes the cooperation between Professor Li Zhi-wei's team at the Plasma and Thin Film Technology Center of MCUT and KAIST professors specializing in plasma technology. MOU with Tzu Chi University Image Source : KAIST Herald KAIST and Tzu Chi University jointly signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on March 19 to promote excellence in medical education and clinical research on regenerative stem cell therapies, promote global well-being, and establish strong collaborations between the two universities. Signed by President Kwang-hyang Lee and CEO of Tzu Chi Education Wang Bon-young, CEO of Tzu Chi Medical Foundation Pan-Jung Wang, and President of Tzu Chi University Ingrid Liu, the accord aims for the mutual sharing of their respective breakthroughs on cancer, brain science and stem cells. During their visit to the university, KAIST professors presented on developing gene and cell therapy technologies for the treatment of brain disorders.
